1st symposium Paris - July 12th 2017

" Ageing and growth: The challenge of the 21st century "

On July 12th 2017, The Chair "*Transitions démographiques, Transitions économiques*" organized the first international symposium on "Ageing and Growth" with the support of "*La Caisse des Dépôts*".

50 speakers coming from 7 different countries participated to the debates all day, in front of an audience of 200 people.

Throughout the day, all sessions led to interesting, stimulating debates in relation with the Chair's 4 areas of research, i.e. VET and second chance, health macroeconomics, securitization in the mortgage market, retirement savings and pension funds.

These debates, confirmed the importance of the ongoing research and modeling effort developed by the Chair, such as:

- **SCOLA** which measures the importance of human capital in the economy and intergenerational mobility
- **MELETE 2** which calculate the sustainability of protection system in the context of demographic and financing evolutions.
- **MLPI** assessing the financial interest of assets transfers in favor of up and coming generation.
- **MERMIF** defining a new system, viable and sustainable of retirement savings.

All communications of this first symposium will be available on line on September 18th 2017.

A second symposium will be organized on July 2018 whose programme will be announced in the coming weeks by a scientific committee.

We remain available to all form of collaboration and discussion with your institutions round this project and we will keep you informed of the organization of our next international symposium.
